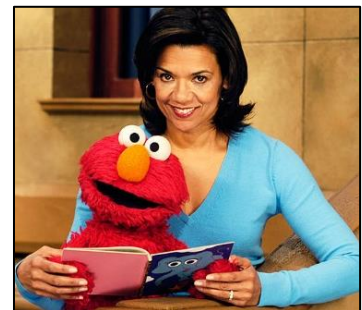

An Emmy-award winning actress, Sonia played Maria on Sesame Street for over 40 years. Children's Center supports and medically assesses children who are suspected victims of abuse and neglect.

A private, nonprofit child abuse intervention center accredited by the National Children's Alliance, children are referred to the Center by law enforcement agencies, child protection workers, parents, teachers, health care providers, and others concerned for their welfare.

We see children for concerns of sexual abuse, physical abuse, emotional abuse, and neglect, including children who witness violence, and/or are exposed to drugs

- Medical examinations performed by licensed medical doctors and nurse practitioners
- Forensic interviews with trained specialists
- Family support services, consultations, referrals, and education
- Prevention education and trainings
